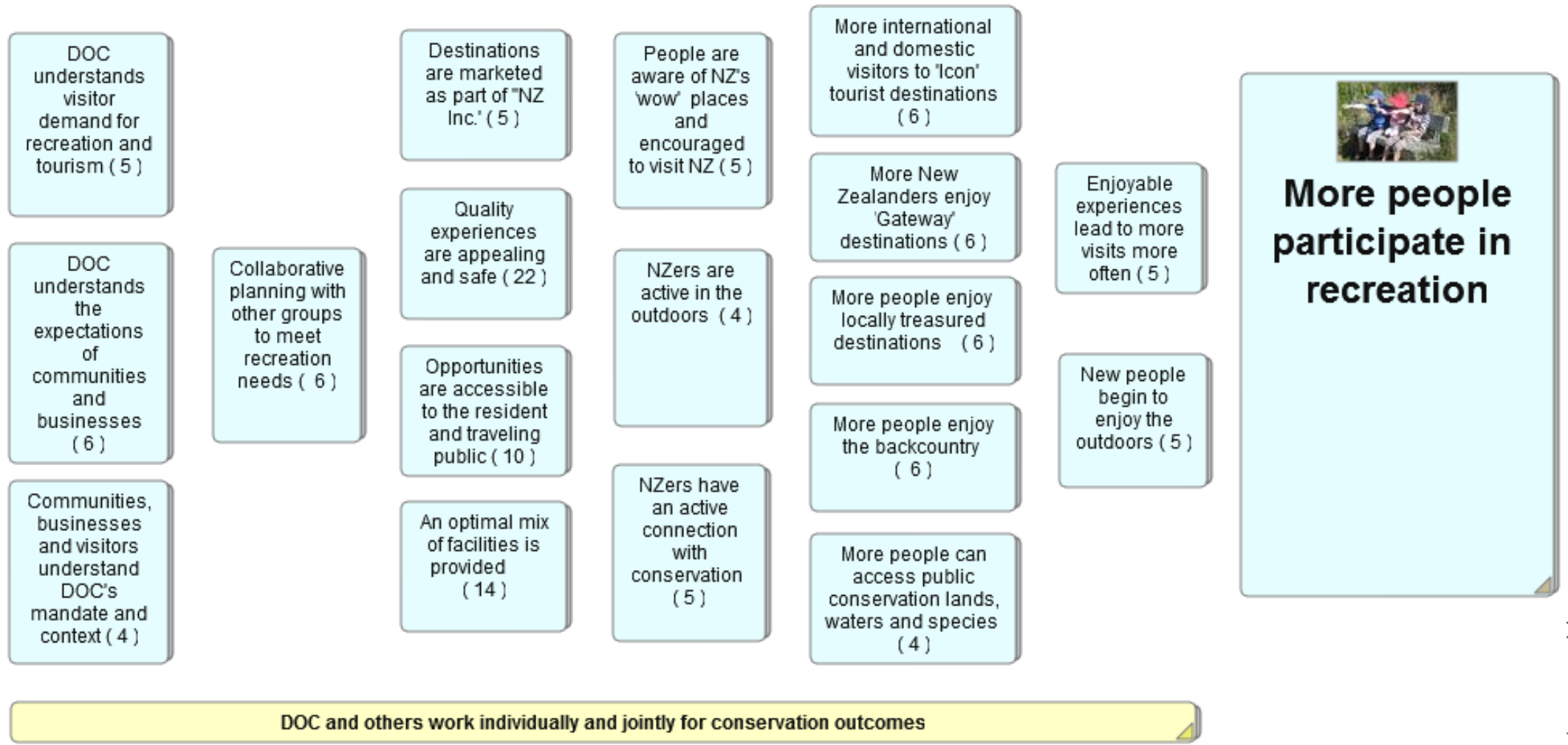

# Department of Conservation DoView Outcomes Model

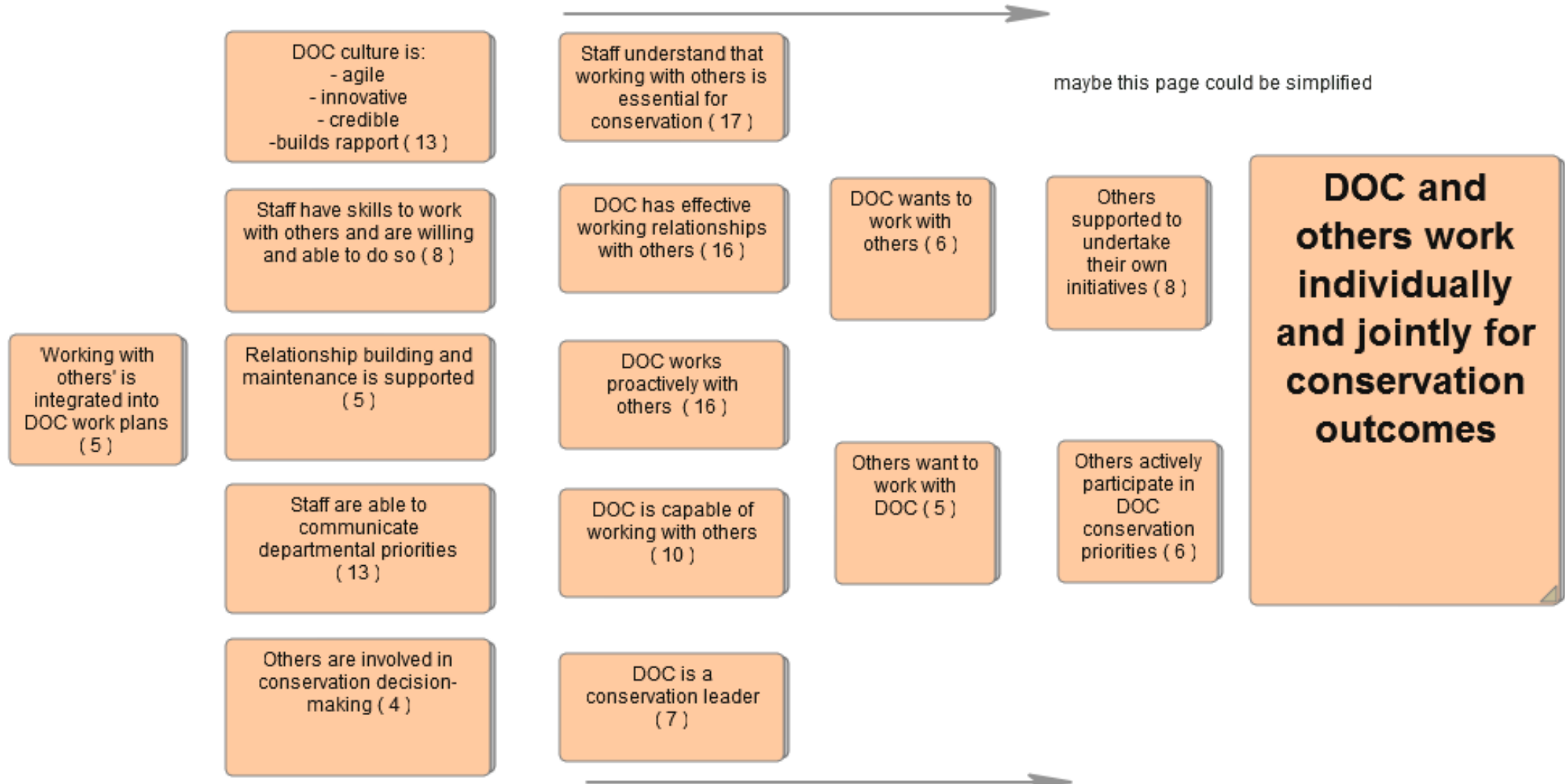
Listing of projects, steps and outcomes and which projects it is believed will influence which steps and outcomes.

The numbers in the boxes are the number of projects influencing that particular step. The next step is to go through the steps in the visual model and rank them in terms of priorities (A, B, C, BAU - Business As Usual).
