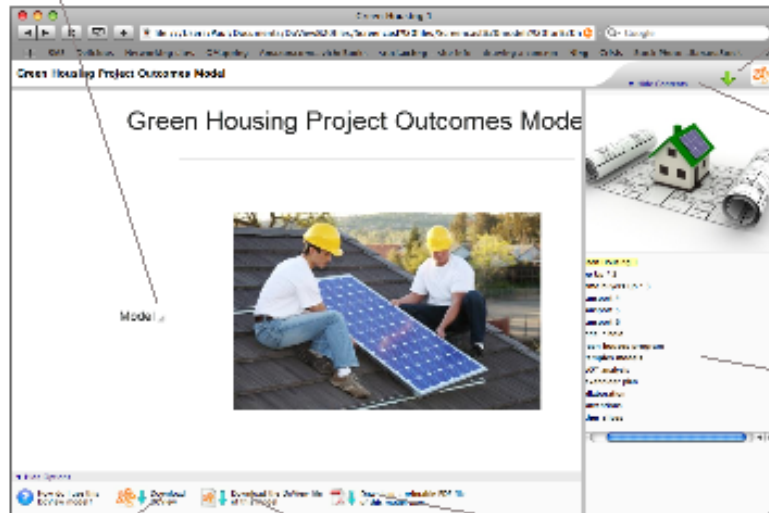

Install a trial version of DoView (doview.com/download.html) and then download this model from the link below and start playing with it.

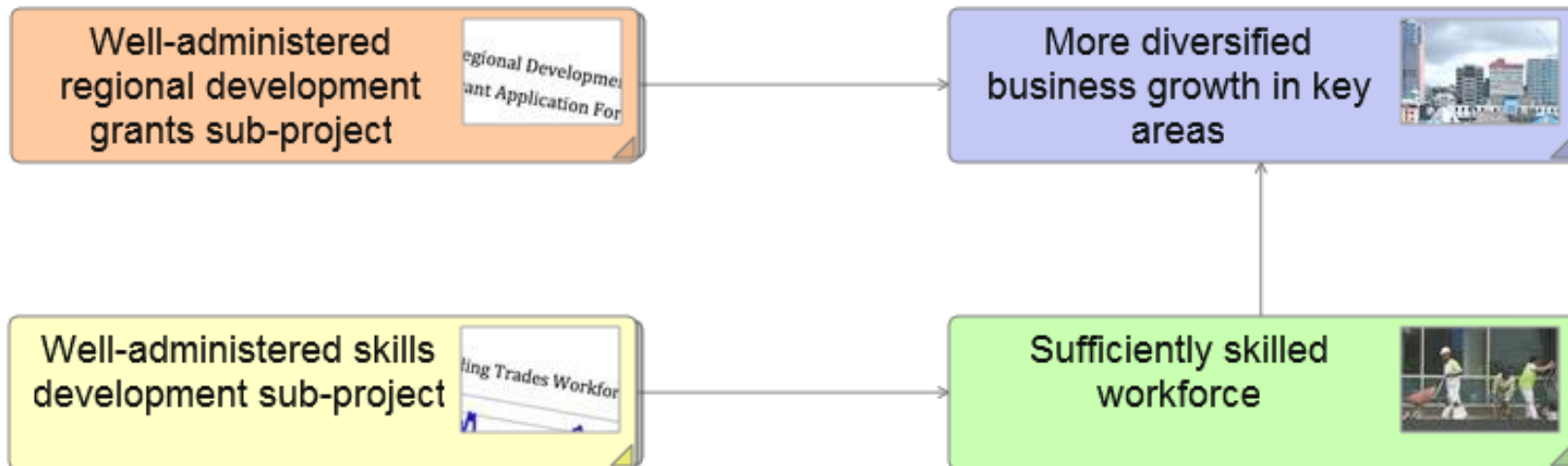

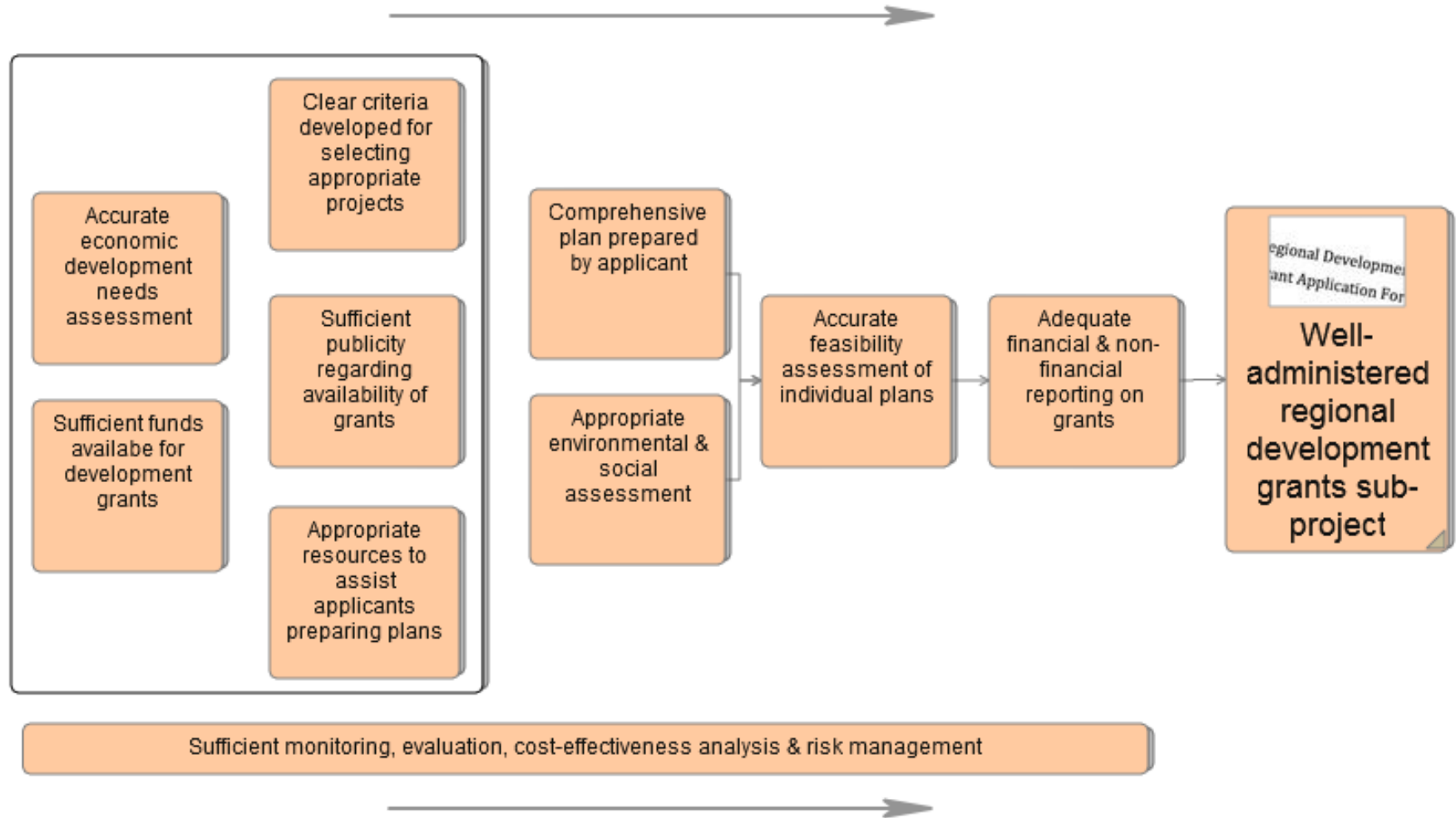

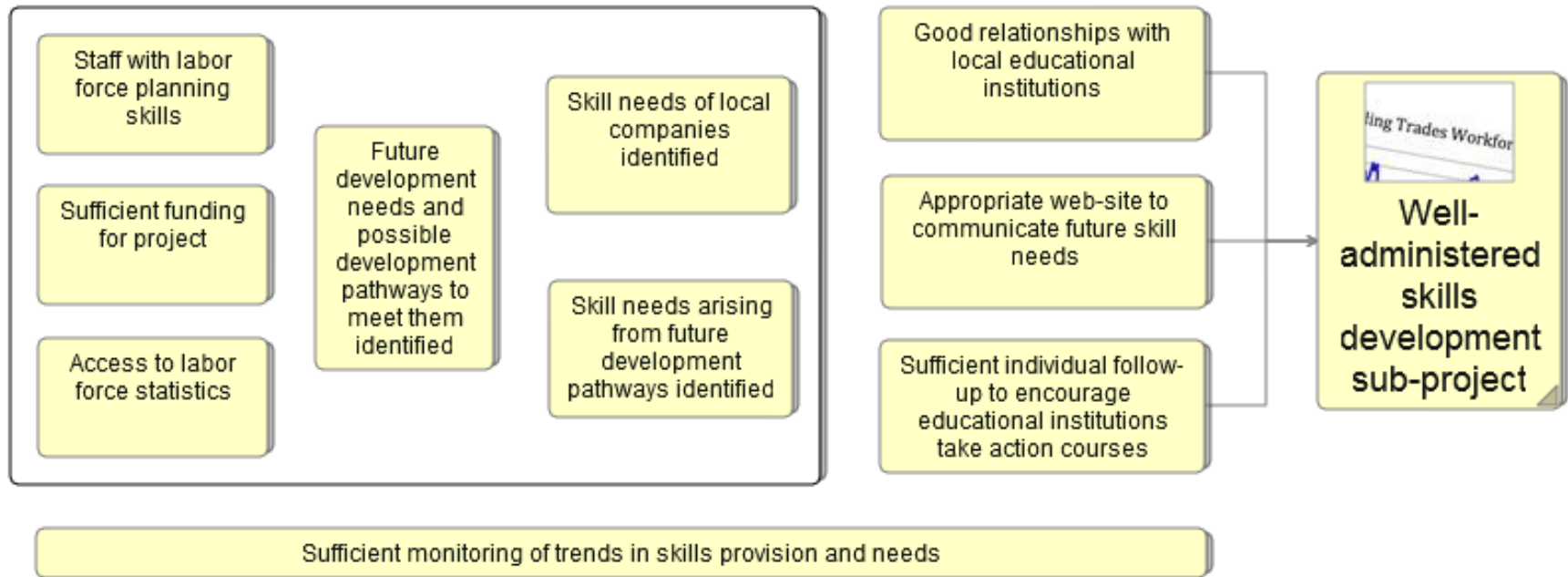

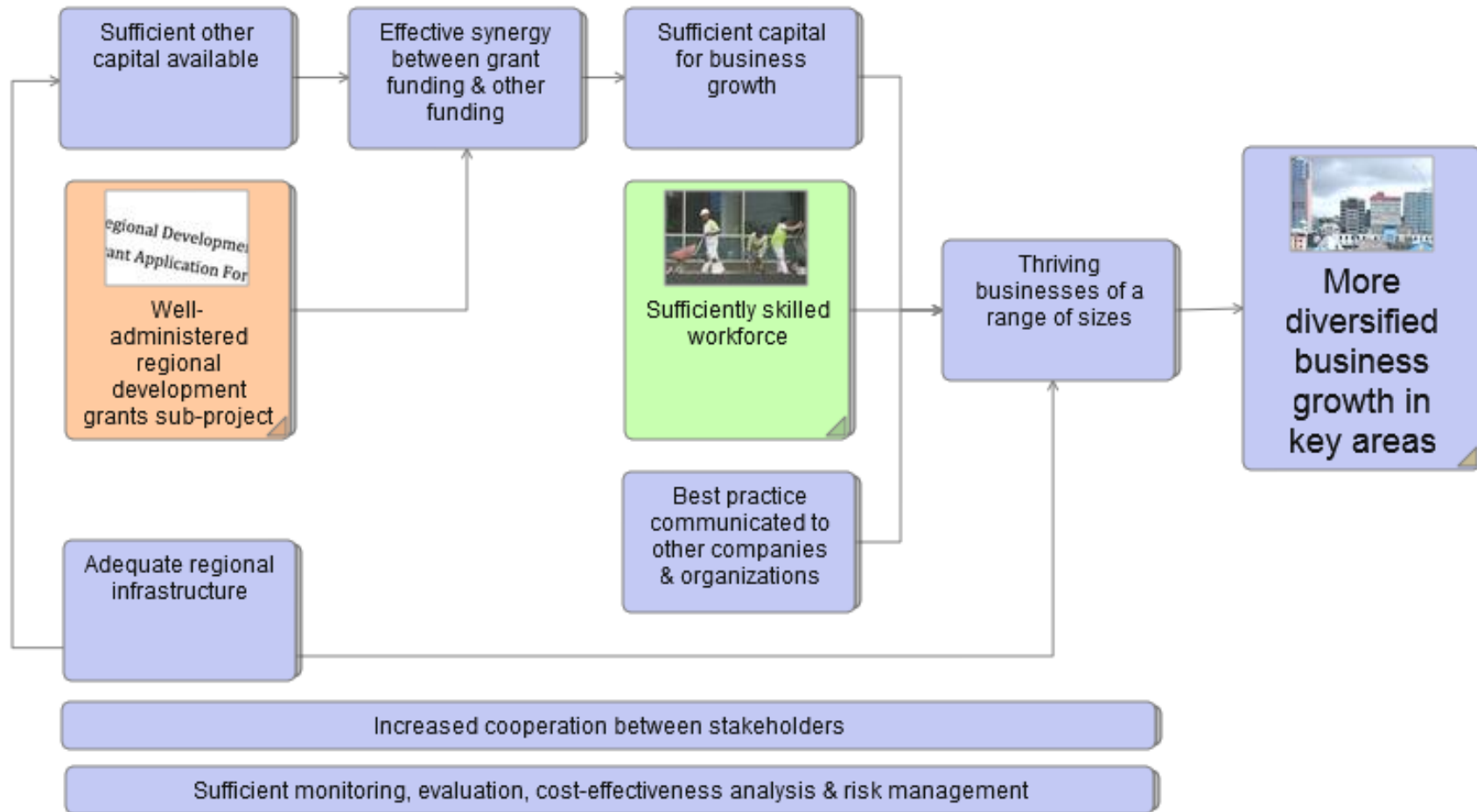

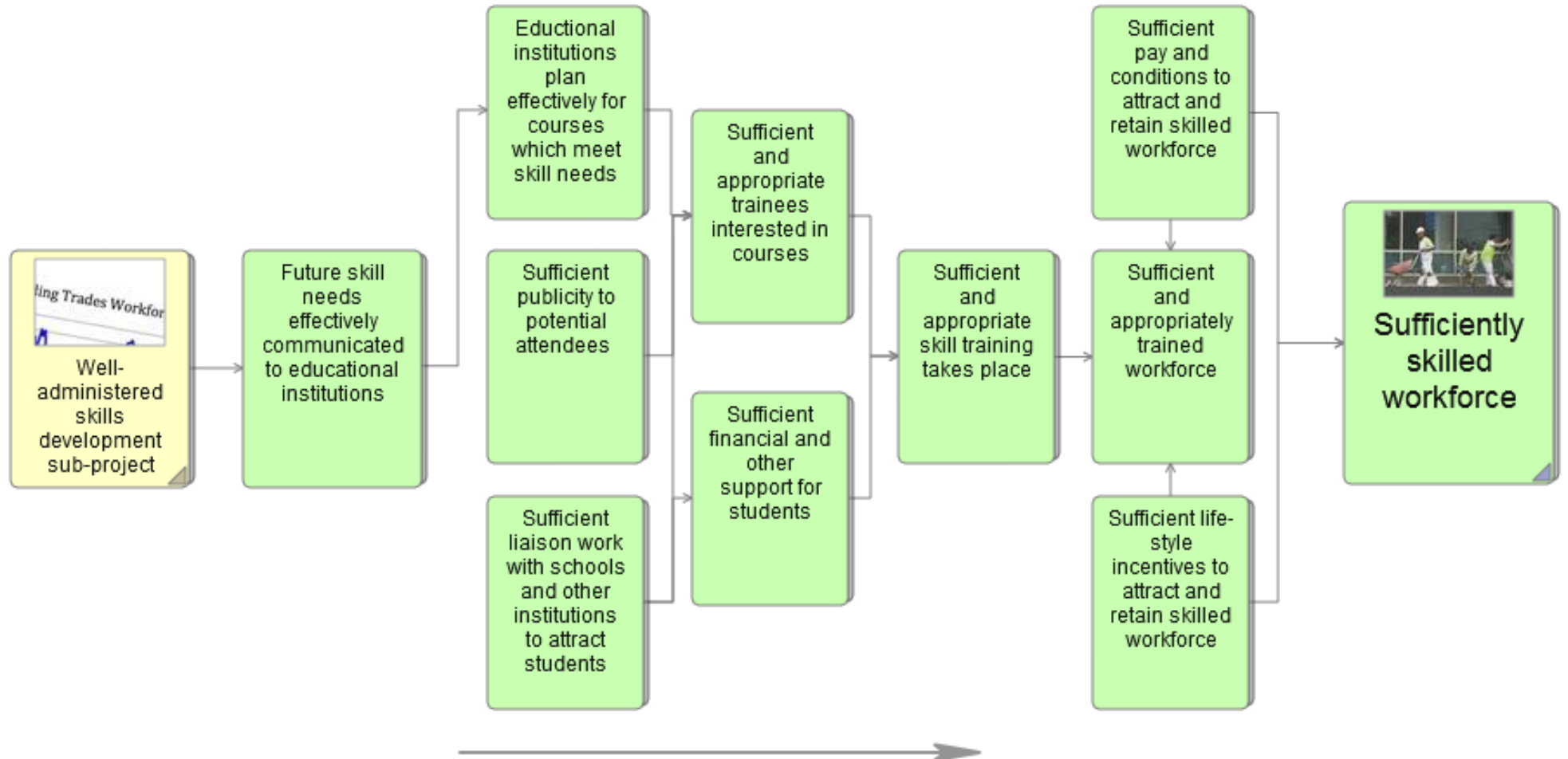

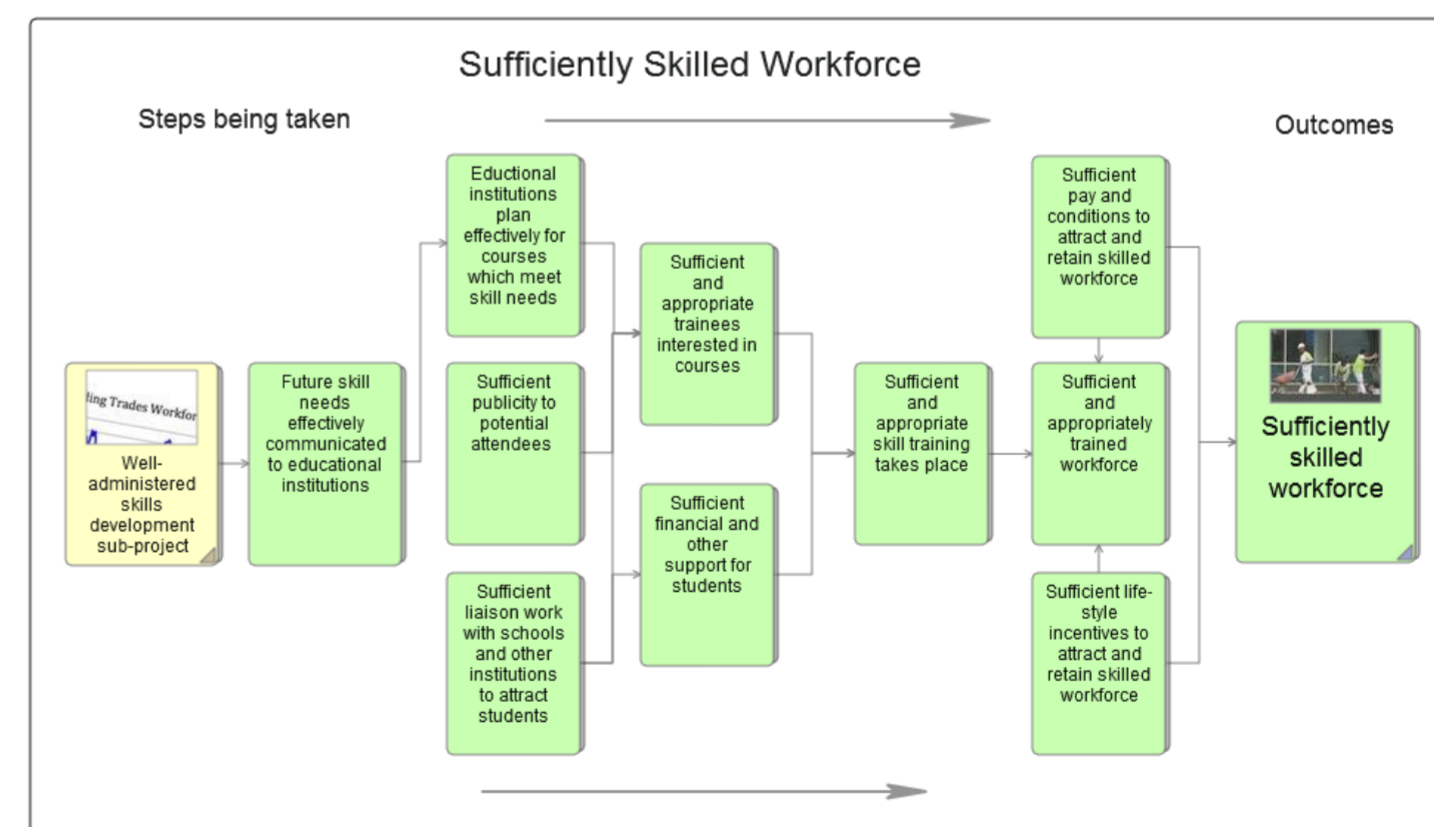

DoView is outcomes software which both lets you make an outcomes model on your PC, and also lets you quickly create a web page version of your model which you can then put up on the internet.

When you are looking at a web page version of a DoView file you can often (if the person who created it included this option) immediately download the DoView file that created the web page model. You can also often download a PDF version of the file.

To download the DoView file, you just need to click on 'Download the DoView File of this Model' icon which you should be able to see at the bottom of your browser screen.

This file was created in DoView 2.0, so you will need to have DoView 2.0 or later installed to be able to use it.
